InstaGrant Supports "One School, One Book" Initiative at Belvidere Elementary

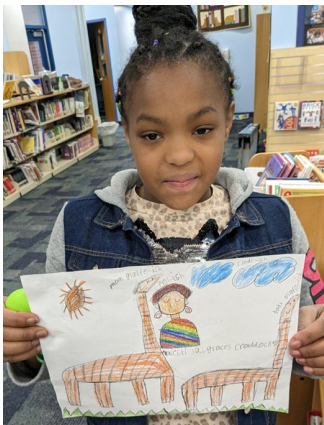
When Ruth Godwin, the Librarian at Belvidere Elementary, received the \$100 InstaGrant for the 2022-23 school year from GEF she knew just how to use it!

Ms. Godwin used the funds, in conjunction with other funds, to buy nearly 100 copies of *Ish* by Peter H. Reynolds. "We bought every student at Belvidere a copy of the book as a One School, One Book initiative," said Godwin.

Throughout December, January, and February, they focused on social/emotional books written by Peter H. Reynolds culminating in a live Zoom event where Peter discussed writing, learning, and his love of art. At the end of his discussion, he taught the students to draw an -ish character and answered questions. Because students had a copy of the book of their own, they were engaged and excited during the Zoom event.
